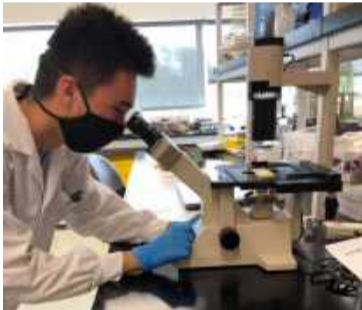


BioCanRx Invests \$10M in Promising New Cancer Immunotherapy Research and Biomanufacturing
